

Change to Forms W-2 and certain Forms 1099-MISC filing deadlines

A new federal law changed the deadline for filing Forms W-2 and Forms 1099-MISC (if reporting nonemployee compensation in Box 7) with the Social Security Administration or [Internal Revenue Service](#) to January 31, beginning in 2017.

The Massachusetts Department of Revenue will also require that employers and other payors submit these forms to the Department no later than January 31, beginning in 2017.

Employers and other payors will use the same processing procedures already in place to submit Forms W-2 and Forms 1099-MISC to the Department. For more information see [Annual Wage and Tax Statements](#).
